2013 JELLYFISH CALENDAR

The calendar report to the left are estimates only.

Jellyfish may be present on any given day. As a general rule, they arrive about 9-12 days after a full moon, and come near the shore to spawn during these times.

How can you avoid them? First, be aware. When there are big schools of box jellyfish, it is usually mentioned on the local news. So make sure that when you get to your hotel, turn on the TV and watch the news for a bit.

Secondly, ask around. Ask the locals about jellyfish (ie hotel staff, lifeguards). When jellyfish show up, it creates a local buzz. So, be sure to ask if jellyfish have been spotted in the area.

Lastly, don't ever touch a dead jellyfish. Even though they're dead, they can still sting!
